- ***On September 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1916, the U.S. Congress passed the Adamson Act.*** The legislation mandated an 8-hour workday for workers in the interstate railroad industry. Congress, with the support of President Woodrow Wilson, supported the legislation as a means of averting a looming nationwide strike by railroad workers.
